Vocabulary

Character: A person or animal in a story.

Setting: Where a story takes place.

Plot: What happens in a story.

Author: A person who writes a story.

Illustrator: The person who draws the pictures for a story.

Habitat: The natural home of a plant or animal, where they live and grow.

Map: A drawing that shows different places, paths, or locations, helping us find our way.

Spring: A season that comes after winter, when flowers begin to bloom and the weather gets warmer.

Easter: A Christian celebration remembering Jesus' resurrection after his death on the cross.
