Staying Safe

- Children feel safe n school. They are pleased hat they are checked on everyday and if an issue happens it is sorted out straight away. The teachers will solve the problem.
- If something happens the teachers still check on you during the next day.
- You are able to talk to any adult in school and you have teachers that you trust so you can go to any adult in school. It does not have to be your class teacher.
- The Lockdown practise helped us feel safer in school and they would like to do this again next Summer term.
- Some children are worried that the fences are not safe. JD said that he and Mr Smith check the fences and they are safe for the school.
- Some children said they are worried to take concerns to teachers and JD reminded the children that we have the Zones of Regulation and the white boards on the Zones that means an adult will ask you if you are okay in school.
- Could we have worry boxes or worry monsters in class for concerns?

- The children in KS2 particularly said they feel their joins are better and they hold their pencil better because of the rhyme they have learnt.
