They knew many key facts about the topic and were able to recall key individuals from the time. All the children were able to explain the impact of Romans on our society now.

1 / 2 - Children were able to tell me about History and the study of the past. They were able to explain how toys have changed over time. This was focused in terms of materials and the examination of artefacts.
