## What does Music look like at Broadwas CE VA Primary School?

- Music is an important part of school life at Broadwas CE Primary School. We know that music helps lift children's spirits, supports important mental health benefits and provides key opportunities to unite the school and celebrate achievements, festivals and key celebrations within the life of the school.
- Music is taught in school as part of a cross curricular topic based theme approach throughout Reception and Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2. - We have close links with The Severn Arts Trust who provide music lessons for our children within school including piano, violin, guitar and ukulele. The school has also taken part in their 'Big Sing' events at the University of Worcester.
- We aim for our children to develop a love of music and to enjoy listening, performing and evaluating different genres and musicians.
- We want them to learn to sing, create and compose music and have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument.
