

Whole School Topic 'Famous for more than Five Minutes' – Summer 1 2020 Week 4 – Pablo Picasso

HISTORY

Find facts about Pablo Picasso. What was his full name? When was his birthday? How old was he when he died?

Why is he famous? What was the first word he said? How old was he when he painted his first picture?

Create a timeline of key events in his life.

Find out about the Spanish Civil War.

Why did Picasso create the picture 'Guernica'?

DESIGN and TECHNOLOGY

Picasso painted guitars during his 'blue' period – can you make a blue guitar from junk?

Create a Cubist sculpture using Lego bricks/cubes.

Create a self-portrait using junk.

Use plasticine to make a sculpture of a face or a person.



ENGLISH

Write a fact file.

Make an art themed word search.

Write a mini biography on the life of Pablo Picasso.

Write your own story called 'The girl with the ponytail' (See essential links)

Be an art critic – choose your favourite Picasso picture and write about why you like it.

GEOGRAPHY

Picasso was born in Spain but lived most of his life in France. Find these two countries on a map. Create fact files about them – capital cities, flags, food etc.

Can you find the small town of Guernica on your map?

Picasso worked for a while in Barcelona – what can you find out about this city?

There are Picasso museums all over the world – can you find out where some of them are?



ART

Research: what can you find out about the method of painting called Cubism that Picasso developed?

Colour mixing – can you make your own colour wheel by mixing paint?

Paint using colour to express mood – blue for sad, pink for happy.

Paint a self-portrait then repeat using Picasso's techniques – use paint or collage using coloured papers or pictures from magazines.

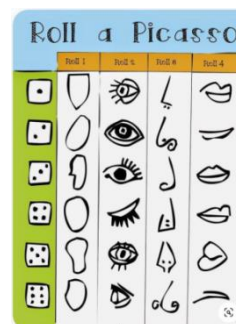
Listen to Spanish guitar music.

MATHS

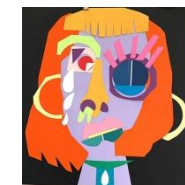
Use dice to help you create your own Picasso!
