Where are the world's largest jungles or rainforests?

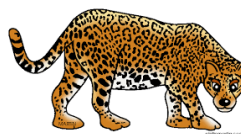
Research the 4 different layers of the rainforest. Draw a diagram with labels and pictures showing each layer and the animals you would find.
