Reading is our top priority – aim to share a story every day! There are books online at [Oxford Owl](#), or if reading one from home to your child, ask them to read words you know they recognise or can sound out phonetically.

Children need to be able to read the 45 High Frequency words for Reception by sight. Little and often is the best way to commit words to memory.

Children should practise their Read Write Inc sounds daily.

Children also need to keep practising their writing skills, both with individual letter formation and/or writing a short sentence each day.
