Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 3/4 visit to Compton Verney - Friday, 18th September 2026

As part of our history topic, Stone Age to Iron Age, we are excited to offer the children in Year 3/4 the opportunity to visit **Compton Verney** in Warwickshire on **Friday, 18th September**. This enriching trip will also support our first set text of the term, Stone Age Boy.

During the visit, the children will explore life in the Stone Age through hands-on activities at a Forest School site. They will build with wattle and daub, prepare the campfire and explore traditional Stone Age food in this day-long programme. The children will be accompanied by Mrs Allen, Mr Dennis, Mrs Langbridge and Mrs Guernsey. The children will be travelling on a coach that will be leaving school at **09:00am** promptly and will return by **3:15pm**.

Children should wear appropriate outdoor clothing that can get messy and, depending on the weather forecast for that week, a waterproof coat and wellies. Your child will need a packed lunch and a full drinks bottle, they may also bring a mid-morning healthy snack should they wish to have one.

The cost of this visit is £24.62 per child, which includes the all-day workshop and the transport costs.

Payments are voluntary; however, without receiving at least the minimum payment of £12.31, the trip, unfortunately, will not be able to go ahead.

Please navigate to the Trips section in your Parent Arbor App, to give consent for your child to participate and make your payment, where there is the option to either pay the full amount of £24.62, or you pay half now and the remainder by Monday 14th September.
