Dear Parents and Carers

Musical Instrument Tuition – 2026/2027

Children in Years 3 and above are offered the opportunity to have musical instrument lessons at school. These lessons are provided by visiting teachers from Severn Arts and are taught on an individual basis during the school day.

We currently have lessons in school for piano, guitar and drums.

The cost of **weekly** tuition lessons, as charged by Severn Arts are:

Piano - £16.38 for a 20-minute lesson.

Guitar - £16.38 for a 20-minute lesson or, £7.88* for a 10-minute lesson

*If enough children sign up for a 10-minute lesson, it is possible to share the lesson.

***Please note this would mean your child would have a 10-minute lesson with the music teacher and would have another child in the music room with them who would be at a similar stage of learning.*

Drumming - £16.38 for a 20-minute lesson or £24.57 for a 30-minute lesson.

Lessons start in the autumn term from week commencing 7th September 2026 until 11th December.

Spring term 2027 from week commencing 4th January 2027 until 19th March 2027.

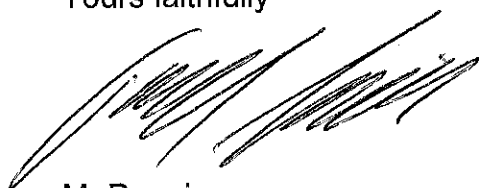
Summer term 2027 from week commencing 12th April 2027 until 9th July 2027.

Before deciding whether your child should have lessons, please consider the following points:

- All tuition fees are payable termly from September 2026 and, are invoiced directly via Worcestershire County Council. Payments for music lessons are not made using Arbor. Details of how and where to pay are printed on the invoice.
- An invoice will be sent to you for 13 x sessions during autumn term, 10 x sessions during spring term and 11 x sessions during summer term.
- **One full term's notice** must be given if you wish to stop lessons;
- Your child will miss part of a class lesson when having music tuition;
- If your child is ill or absent for any other reason, it will not usually possible to rearrange the lesson nor to arrange a refund;
- If your child is on a school trip or involved in a school event, we will endeavour to rearrange or cancel the lesson, **but this may not always be possible**;
- Pupils are assessed regularly and you will receive a written report at the end of the academic year.

If you would like your child to have, **or continue to have**, music lessons commencing September 2026, please complete the attached form and return it to the school office **no later than Friday 26th June 2026**.
