**RE: Years 3/4/5/6 Trip to The Hive, Worcester – Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June**

Our KS2 children have been invited to The Hive to take part in the Schools Summer Reading Challenge Festival on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June.

The children will take part in 2 workshops. One workshop will be delivered by the library and the second by a local artist. The artist sessions this year are delivered by Catt Standen and centre around the story of the Worcestershire Black Pear being added to the Worcestershire coat of arms by Elizabeth I.

The children will be creating pear blossoms which will contribute to an art sculpture which will be displayed in Friary Walk throughout the summer where people of the city will be able to come and engage with the piece as well as engage in a trail of larger pear sculptures that Catt will place across the city.

We will be travelling to and from The Hive on a coach, leaving school at 09:00am and returning at approximately 2:30pm.

Children should come into school wearing their school uniform. They will need a packed lunch and a drink.

The cost of this visit is £3.60 per child.
