Dear Parents and Carers

RE: Year 3/4 Trip to Bennetts Farm, Worcester – Wednesday 8th July

The children in Year 3 and 4 will be taking part in trip to Bennett's Farm on Wednesday 8th July.

As part of their Geography topic 'Where does our food come from?' the children will be entering a commercial farm to see, touch, hear, and smell exactly where their food comes from. The children will understand the importance of farms - after all, food doesn't just appear on supermarket shelves!

They will meet the cows inside the sheds and find out all about how the farmers grow the food that they eat to help make lots of nutritious milk and beef. The children will be able to step into the milking parlour and watch some cows being milked.

We will be travelling to and from Bennett's Farm on a coach, leaving school at 09:45am and returning at approximately 1:30pm.

Children should come into school wearing clothes they do not mind getting mucky, old shoes or trainers **and bring with them a pair of wellies**. They will also need a packed lunch and a drink.

The cost of this visit is £9.00 per child which includes the cost of the transport and a 'Bennetts' ice cream before leave the farm.
