Year 3/4 Visit to 'Explore The Past', at The Hive, Worcester – Thursday 12th February

As part of our History topic on The Anglo-Saxons, we are excited to offer the children in Year 3/4 the opportunity to visit The Hive in Worcester on **Thursday 12th February**.

During their visit, the children will take part in a two-hour workshop on Anglo-Saxons: Who were these invaders & settlers? led by Explore The Past.

Using a replica skeleton and grave goods, the children will explore what a typical Saxon grave and local archaeological evidence can tell us about these historic invaders' way of life. Sessions will introduce life, death, and belief in the Anglo-Saxon world, as well as covering an introduction to archaeology, Anglo-Saxon trade, economy, and how objects were made.

The children will be accompanied by Mrs Allen, Mrs Champken, Mrs Brown and Mrs Chudley, they will travel on a coach that will leave school at **09:30am** and will return by **12:30pm**.

Children should wear their school uniform (and depending on the weather forecast for that week/day be prepared to bring a waterproof coat). They may also bring a mid-morning healthy snack should they wish to have one.

The cost of this visit is £12.45 per child, which includes the workshop and the coach.
